

Fifty Austrians Left Yesterday.

The war has not up to the present caused any noticeable exodus of foreigners from the Sault. There are, of course, a few leaving, but those in touch with the movement say that the number is very little greater than is usual at this season of the year. Most of the foreigners in the Sault are Italians, and while some of them are leaving, they are not going on account of the war, as Italy, up to the present, is not involved.
