

U. S. Germans Might Invade Our Country

Ottawa, Aug. 6.—The Free Press says: An invasion of Canada by the Germans of Milwaukee and other places in Wisconsin is feared by the United States authorities, according to reports from very reliable authorities.

It is said that there are a few thousand men of the United States border rangers along the frontier today, and that they are concentrating at points where trouble may be expected.

If Germans from Wisconsin or other parts of the states attempt to come across the border they will be infringing the international regulations and the United States, it is thought, will have to stop them.

There are about 1,500,000 Germans in the Northern States, and it is believed that many of them possess arms.

The same thing that happened in the Fenian raid is feared from the Wisconsin Germans. Old rifles which were used in the Spanish-American war was sold by the United States government for \$1.80 each, and a great many of the Germans bought them up.
