

Consulate Invaded

VANCOUVER, Aug. 6.—The big double-headed eagle above the door of the German consulate offices in the Bower Building was torn from its supports when a crowd of men invaded the block and made for the consulate department with threats of destruction. Having thrown down the "insignia" of arms and trampled on it, the party left peaceably after breaking a little glass and defacing the signs of the consulate doors. Immigration and military officers here are preparing to stop all German and Austrian subjects, who may endeavor to flee to the United States.
