Given Liberty on Account of Good Behavior and Have Secured Steady Work MUST REPORT REGULARLY

There have been thirty-two of the

interned aliens paroled during the past few months, said Capt. Coleman

this morning. Men who have had a good record and who are sure of steady period, like a year, are recommended to Ottawa and released on condition that they report regularly to a government official, such as police officer, justice of the peace or postmaster.

One case he mentioned where a

young man had been interned for not reporting as required, but his father owned a farm and asked that his son be allowed to come out to help him at harvest. Having a good record and agreeing to report regularly he was allowed to go.

A number of the aliens are employed under guard to clear up the exhibition grounds.
