

Bridge is Burned; Spy Suspect Shot

Engine on Quebec Railway Wrecked, With Loss of Three Lives

Ottawa, Ont., Aug. 10.—Word was received this morning at the Militia Department that a bridge on the Quebec and Lake St. John Railway was set fire and a train smashed through it, killing three persons. A militia guard who was on duty shot a man who was loitering at the bridge. The accident took place near Val Cartier and it is suspected that the work is that of a German spy. The significance of dispatch lies in the fact that the Quebec and Lake St. John Railway which is part of the C.N.R. system, is the line which will be required to transport the Canadian troops to Val Cartier, the mobilization grounds at Quebec.
