

AUSTRIANS WANT WAR, NOT WORK

Austrians hanging around the consulate of their country were yesterday offered work in railroad construction. Three hundred were required at \$2.25 a day, with board, but none accepted. Today a number were offered work on the Greater Winnipeg Waterways but none would accept.

Two city policemen still guard the consulate, which is besieged by a number of Austrians seeking papers as evidence that they applied to go back to fight but were stopped from doing so by the Canadian authorities. The consul is still in charge attending to his business as usual.
