

ATTEMPT TO WRECK EXPRESS NEAR GRIMSBY STATION

REPORT THAT SOME MEN HAVE
BEEN ARRESTED ON SUS-
PICION.

Grand Trunk officials report that a deliberate attempt has been made to wreck the fast express running between Buffalo and Detroit. Attached to this train is a coach with Toronto passengers for Buffalo, who leave Toronto at 4.10 by the Limited Express. It is said that close to Grimsby station piles were driven into the roadbed and stones piled around them. Some foreigners were seen in the vicinity a few hours before the arrival of the train, and a number of detectives have been sent to try and find the offenders. Late last night it was reported that some men had been arrested on suspicion.
