

# GERMANS IN OTTAWA SEEK AID FROM THE AMERICAN CONSUL

Ottawa, Aug. 12.—American Consul-General Foster has received a number of applications from German subjects in Ottawa soliciting his aid in facilitating their return to the fatherland. These he has placed on file, as he has not yet received any instructions covering this case from Washington. Till such is forthcoming, he will not consider the applications in any way. In Montreal and Vancouver, where there are resident German consuls, the latter have turned over their affairs to the American representatives.

There is no German consul in Ottawa, and it is likely that the American consul-general will be instructed from Washington within a few days to look after the interests of the subjects of the kaiser.
