of the German army.

He inquired yesterday at the office of Mayor Powers whether the organizing of 5,000 Germans in St. Paul for the purpose of invading Canada would be considered a violation of American

considered a violation of American neutrality. Mayor Powers referred him to the office of the United States district attorney. Mr. Meyer has not yet seen the district attorney.

"I have reason to believe," said Mr. Meyer "that there might be considerable opposition to the plan."
