

Canada at War With Austria

Consuls Given Time to Leave

Ottawa, Aug. 13.—Now that Great Britain has declared war on Austria-Hungary, proclamations will be issued to-day declaring that Canada is also at a state of war. Action will be taken at once in regard to Austrian reservists in Canada. They will be notified that they will be detained in Canada, and will not be molested provided they go quietly about their business. They will be expected, the same as the German reservists, to go to the nearest authority and declare their intentions. Austrian Consuls will likely be given forty-eight hours to leave Canada.
