AID FOR THE WEST. Government to Care For Farmers Who Lost Their Crops.

Ottawa, Aug. 13 .- After a conference to-day with Hon. Robert Rogers, R. B. Bennett, M.P., and Commissioner Perry, R.N.W.M.P., Bruce Walker, of the Immigration Department, Winnipeg, left for the West last night to put into effect the Government's

scheme for the relief of the settlers who suffered from crop failure this

year. To enable them to continue farming operations next year provisions will be made for the settlers

to retain their stock.

Free transportation from the affected areas to the good crop districts have been secured for the settlers.
