## TAKEN PRISONERS IHIS MORNING One Hundred Came in By Special Train from A. C. R.

THIRTY AUSTRIANS

COMPANY OF SIST
MET THE TRAIN

Construction Camps.

Baggage and Person of All of Them Was Searched

About 106 Austrians arrived in the Sault this morning by special A.C.R. train from the construction work on the line between Oba and Hearst, where 400 men were let off work yesterday. The train was met by a company of the 51st Rifles, who lined up on both sides of it, and letting the Austrians off six at a time took them into the waiting room at the station and searched them and their baggage. Thirty were taken in charge by the regiment and marched down to the armory, while the remainder were released. No information is given out as to why the thirty mere made prison-

ers. There was no disturbance of any

kind.
