## HOLD PRISONERS OF WAR Militia Company Called to Guard Hungarians and Austrians. Buffalo, N. Y., Aug. 26 .- A com-

pany of militia arrived at Bridgeburg. across the Niagara River from here, today to guard twenty-six Austrians and Hungarians who had been taken from eastbound trains during the last few days. The foreigners were bound for New York, where they intended to

take passage to their native countries. The number of prisoners increased so rapidly that the village authorities

were doubtfut of their ability to hold them and asked for the militia. Ningara Falls, Ont., has nineteen

prisoners of war, including German, Austrian and Hungarian reservists.
