## HAVE POLICE POWERS Owing to Condition Consequent on War, Action is Taken.

IMMIGRATION FORCE

Power has been bestowed on Dominion immigration inspectors giving taken the same authority as Dominion policemen. The new regulation was ordered to be adopted, by Col. Sheewood, chief commissionar of the Do-

wood, chief commission, of the Dominion police, the local immigration department receiving notice of the change on Tuesday.

The officers have been given this new power indefinitely, although it

is certain that it will last only as long as the present war conditions prevail. Owing to their familiarity with the different nationalities on account of being in daily contact with the vari-

being in daily contact with the variday of the action was taken. The immigration officers need no warrant to arrest a man, no matter what the charge, and can execute their power

to arrest a man, no matter what the charge, and can execute their power any place in the Dominion of Canada. However, as far as immigration routine work is concerned they have only the same amount of power.
