

RAILWAY GUARD KILLED ON DUTY

Ottawa Believes German Sympathizer is Slayer of
Patrick Morgan

DOMINION POLICE ON JOB

Every German and Austrian in
That District to be
Arrested

Ottawa, Aug. 29.—Word was received early this morning by Col. Sam Hughes, Minister of Militia, that Patrick Morgan, a Canadian Pacific Railway guard on the railway bridge at Smith's Falls, was shot and killed at an early hour. It is believed that he was shot by a German sympathizer. Col. Sherwood, chief of the Dominion Police and head of the Canadian Secret Service, left at eight o'clock for Smith's Falls with a squad of Dominion police under orders to arrest every German and Austrian in Smith's Falls and district.

Coming after the shooting of a guard at Soulange Canal this has stirred the militia authorities. The German and Austrian reservists will not likely be treated as leniently as they have been.
