German Urged Son . To Return to War Letter to Ontario Teuton Was Written Before Outbreak

A letter written by a German re-

siding in Berlin to his son in Canada. calling the latter home to fight for the Kaiser, has been brought to the notice of the Provincial authorities, who now possess the document. The letter was written on August 1st the day upon which Germany declared war on Russia, and before any de-

finite move was made on France. After anathematizing France, the veteran father calls on his son to hasten back and help write "an improved edition of 1570."
