AUSTRIAN RESERVISTS APPEAR IN POLICE COURT AT FORT WILLIAM TODRY

Shot Gun and Rifle Had Been Found on His Premises—A Warning to Others.

Fort William, Ont., Sept. 21.—The

first case of breaking the order-incouncil which set forth that all alien enemys of Great Britain should not be in possession of any firearms or any explosives after Sept. 15, occurred this morning when two Austrian army reservists appeared in police court. A shotgun and a repeating rifle were found on their premises. They were given a nominal fine and it was pointed out by the court that the next person arrested on a similar charge would be given the full extent of the new law, which is a maximum fine of \$500.
