

POWERS OF CENSORSHIP

**Likely to be Considerably Enlarged in
Canada.**

Ottawa, Sept. 23.—It is understood that an order in council will shortly be passed by the government, giving the Dominion authorities more control over telegraph and telephone lines while the war continues. Just what measures of control will be assumed is not known, but it is believed that the powers of the board of censor, established at the outbreak of the war, will be considerably enlarged.
