

AUSTRIANS ARRESTED

**Reservist in Nova Scotia Refuses to
Keep Peace.**

Sydney, N.S., Sept. 24.—An Austrian reservist named Peter Andrew, working in the mines near here, was arrested this morning, charged with the possession of explosives for an unlawful purpose. He refused to swear to keep the peace and was delivered to the military authorities. Jari Grabokawi and Cashimir Capello, said to be officers, respectively, in the German and Austrian armies, are also under detention at the military prison.
