

# MORE WAR PRISONERS PLACED IN BARRACKS

Eight more German prisoners were brought to Winnipeg Saturday by the Royal Northwest Mounted Police. The prisoners of war are all German reservists whose conduct has been such that the police of the west decided it advisable to send them to the concentration camp which has been formed at Fort Osborne barracks. Major H. D. B. Ketchin stated Saturday afternoon that all the prisoners were in the guard house, but had not yet been taken over by the military authorities. This now makes 16 German prisoners of war in Winnipeg.
