Some 50 to 100,000 Austrians and Germans in Canada Need Watching (Special to the Editorial Journal Finds Ottawa OTTAWA, Oct. 31.—One of the big

problems which is pressing for solution by the government at the present time is the handling of the Austrian and German aliens in Canada. In addition the danger from reservists in the country over whom it is felt there

country over whom it is felt there should be stricter surveillance, there is the question of feeding Austrians and Germans who are out of work. Big employers of labor have been dis-

missing their unskilled men of these nationalities and these find difficulty in securing work. The government refuses to allow them to leave the country so that the problem of feed-

country so that the problem of igeoming and keeping the minust be faced. Officials of the labor department are investigating at the present time to lind out how many allen enemies are employed in the larger cities. They may be rounded up and placed in con-

centration camps. It is estimated that there are from fifty to a hundred thousand Austrian and German aliens in Canada at the present time. A thorough search for weapons is being made and it is likely they will all be compelled.
