

FOREIGNERS NOW REPORTING TO THE POLICE NUMBER 400

Most of Them are Austrians,
and a Few Germans are
Among the Number.

From statistics held by the city Police Department approximately four hundred Germans and Austro-Hungarian prisoners of war are reporting weekly to the chief of police.

Every German or Austro-Hungarian in the city is considered a prisoner if he is not a Canadian citizen, and the yard given him by the Police Department protects him from interruption by the police or militia providing he is peaceful and does not attempt to give out any information of use to the enemies of Britain, or her allies.

Most of the four hundred who report are Austrians, but a few are Germans. They are mostly of a class of foreigners not fit for service in the army.
