

German Reservist Arrested on Border

Was Notified to Report to Police But Attempted to Escape

Still another German reservist, Paul Jacko, who had neglected to report himself to the police and sign the necessary papers, is under arrest. He was caught at Niagara on Saturday as he was leaving for the States with his wife. The latter is under custody in a hotel while her husband is under guard in the Niagara Falls Armouries. He will be brought to Stanley Barracks to-day. Jacko had been living at a house on Niagara streets in this city and last Friday, when it was learned that he was a reservist, he was notified to come to the Detective Department the next day. Although he promised to do so, he failed to put in an appearance and two officers were sent to arrest him. At the house they learned that he had left with his wife. The border cities were immediately notified and the couple were apprehended as they were attempting to purchase tickets at Niagara, on the Canadian side.
