

CANADA TO AID NEEDY RESERVISTS OF ENEMY NATIONS.

Ottawa, Oct. 28.—Food and shelter will be provided, by the Canadian government for the large numbers of German and Austrian army reservists stranded in Montreal, Toronto, Winnipeg and other cities. Employment will be found for as many of them as possible. They would be arrested if they attempted to leave the Dominion, and it is feared many of them will freeze or starve during the winter unless aided by the government.
