

## STEPS TAKEN TO STOP PRO-GERMAN PROPAGANDA

**STRICTER CENSORSHIP WILL BE  
ESTABLISHED OVER PAPERS  
ENTERING AND IN CANADA.**

Ottawa, Oct. 29.—The Government is taking steps to stop so far as possible a persistent pro-German and pro-Austrian agitation in some of the foreign settlements, particularly in western Canada, which might later on lead to dangerous outbreaks. A pro-German propaganda is being carried on wherever possible in Canada by German agents and sympathizers in the United States. German pamphlets printed in the English, German, Austrian and Hungarian languages are being mailed into Canada surreptitiously, and some articles of a decidedly pro-German character have been appearing in a few of the German papers in the west, particularly in Alberta.

The Government intends to establish a considerably stricter censorship over the entry and publication of this sort of literature in Canada, and if warnings sent out to German editors in Canada are not observed, more drastic action will be promptly taken. As one step towards counteracting this pro-German propaganda all German papers in Canada will probably be required to publish in full the British white paper, setting forth the British side of the case and the causes of the war.

## GALT'S FUND REACHES TOTAL ABOUT \$42,000

**THIS MEANS ABOUT \$3.50 PER  
CAPITA OF POPULATION AND  
ALL PAYABLE IN YEAR.**

Galt, Oct. 29.—The Galt Patriotic Fund has now reached a total of about \$42,000. The final returns have not yet been made, so that it is impossible to announce the exact figures. The total represents a contribution of about \$3.50 per capita, and appears all the more liberal when it is known that all subscriptions are payable within one year, no two-year subscriptions having been taken, as is the case in many other places.
