

# PRISONERS OF WAR

**Eleven Locked Up in Barracks at  
Winnipeg Since Saturday.**

Winnipeg, Nov. 2.—Eleven military prisoners, it is understood, have been brought to Winnipeg since Saturday night and interned at the Fort Osborne barracks. These prisoners, it is said, were all arrested in military district 10 by members of the Northwest Mounted Police, who brought them to Winnipeg. On Sunday night, numerous members of this force were to be seen on the downtown streets. It is rumored that this is only the first batch of a group of prisoners numbering almost thirty which have been arrested in the district.
