

RELIEVE UNEMPLOYED

Important Meeting of Officials to be Held in Calgary

A gathering of representatives of the Dominion government, the Alberta provincial government and of the various cities in Alberta will take place Friday, November 8, at Calgary for the purpose of discussing ways and means for relieving the unemployed situation in the province.

A. Farnilo, secretary of the Edmonton Trades and Labor Council, and secretary of the Alberta Federation of Labor, has received a telegram from Mr. English at Calgary stating that this meeting will be held in the southern city and that R. E. Bennett will represent the Dominion government. The Alberta government has been asked to send one or more of its members and the mayors of Lethbridge, Medicine Hat and Calgary will be in attendance. The city of Edmonton has been asked to send a representative.
