GENERAL OTTER TO INVESTIGATE ALIEN

ENEMY PROBLEM

MONTREAL, Nov. 5.—Major-General Sir William Otter, C. R., C. V. O., former inspector-general of Canadian militia, who has been appointed by the federal government to direct the work of carrying out the order-in-council respecting "alien enemies," arrived here vesterday.

General Otter announces that he will visit all the principal cities of the Dominion, and thereafter recommend plans to carry into full effect the intention of the government to guard the country from danger.
