

STOP STREET SALE OF GERMAN PAPERS

Offensive Publications Are Not
Allowed Use of
Mails

WILL END DISTRIBUTION

Postoffice Given Wide Powers
Under Recent Order-in-
Council

Ottawa, Nov. 12.—Street sales in Canada of pro-German publications, foreign or otherwise, are being investigated to-day by the postoffice authorities and definite action to restrain the distribution of offensive publications will be taken in a few days. By the Order-in-Council recently passed dealing with such papers, authority was conferred upon the postoffice authorities to control their circulation by any method, and making it a criminal offence to sell them or have them in one's possession. Under this wide authority the officials will take action to control the distribution of these publications.
