WILL ENFORCE SEDITION LAW

OTTAWA, Ont. - The order-incouncil making it a criminal offense to circulate or possess seditious anti-British and German papers, which are coming into Canada from American cities, is to be rigidly enforced, it is said. The matter is to be taken up by the postmaster-general, and special officers will be appointed to enforce the law. The penalty is \$5,000 fine or two years' imprisonment. There is said to be a heavy circulation of such papers in Montreal.
