
Ottawa So Decides, To Save Important Industries.

Ottawa, Nov. 16.—An order-in-council has been passed relaxing in a certain degree the regulations against trading with the enemy. It is provided that a transaction not clearly permissible under the recent proclamation would be in the public interest in the case of material necessary for the maintenance of Canadian industries, and that a license may be issued on behalf of his majesty permitting such a transaction.

It is recommended as an instance that the minister of customs be authorized to issue licenses permitting a manufacturer using magnetite to trade with enemy wherever it is established that the materials are necessary for the maintenance of such industries.
