

# TREASON CHARGE AGAINST GUARD AT CHIPPAWA

Some light is thrown upon the request, emanating from the military, that the charge against two brothers Snyder should be held in camera, by news which comes from Ottawa. A correspondent there writes:—A military guardman, said to be a Canadian citizen, has been arrested at Chippawa upon the serious charge of assisting German reservists across the border.

It is stated that the prisoner was receiving a rake-off from every man whom he succeeded in getting past the immigration authorities.

This is the second charge of the kind laid since the war commenced, a man named Schaefer being now held for trial at Montreal for assisting Germans and Austrians to get away.

The charge is treason, and the maximum punishment is death.
