BRANDON MAY BE WINTER PRISON

Inquiries are being made with a view to sending all German and Austrian prisoners, now interned here, to Brandon.

Major H. D. B. Ketchen, acting as-

sistant adjutant-general, has written to the authorities at Brandon to see

whether arrangements can be made for quartering them in the winter fair building. No more can be handled here and others are likely to arrive from the west at any moment. The R.N.W.M.P. have arrested several during the past day or two, and they are being held at Regina until some suitable place can be found for them Then the number will be added to here for all unnaturalized Gruans and Austrians not reporting will be placed under arrest.
