bec, was made known this afternoon when the photographic department of Livernois Studios, this city, esttablished from their collection of plates that Hoffman, while he was in the employ of the Quebec Harbor Commission had ordered copies of a blue print chart of the harbor from Sillery to the Island of Urleans. It is not known yet whether these negatives were used to make a num-ber of copies for the personal use of Hoffman, as he was at liberty, as a draughtsman for the Commissioners to go through all the documents be-leaging to that body, and who, fur-thermore, had the initiative of ordering copies of blue prints, charts, or whatever document he saw fit
