

## May Exclude Unfriendly Papers. . . . .

Ottawa, Nov. 16.—Exclusion from Canada of certain American publications accused of being pro-German in sympathy and in the character of their articles has been strongly suggested to the government and a decision will be reached this week. The Review of Reviews, Saturday Evening Post and the Literary Digest have been particularly designated as fit subjects for exclusion. It is extremely doubtful that such drastic action will be taken, especially with reference to papers who give both sides of the war argument.
