

## **FOUR PUBLICATIONS BARRED.**

Ottawa, Nov. 21.—German publications in the United States conducting an insidious campaign and containing highly offensive articles against privileges of the mails in Canada, and the allies are being deprived of their circulation suppressed in keeping with the recent Government order. It is announced today that under the War Measures Act, the circulation of the following publications

is prohibited:

"The Fatherland," a weekly paper published in New York city.

"The Vital Issue," a weekly paper published in New York city.

"Truth About Germany. Facts About the War," a pamphlet published in New York city.

"New York Staats Zeitung," a German daily newspaper published in New York city.

It is a criminal offence to sell, circulate or have in one's possession any of these publications, and the offence is punishable by heavy fine or imprisonment.

This list of prohibited publications will shortly be supplemented.
