

AUSTRIAN ARRESTED AT BEVERLY WITH SUPPLY OF ARMS

Nick Bodonax Has Three Ross Rifles, One Pump Gun and Quantity of Ammunition

Three Ross rifles, 475 rounds of ammunition and a Winchester 12-gauge pump gun have been found in the residence of Nick Bodonax, an Austrian, at Beverly. What was the object of the Austrian in having such a collection concealed in his home is now being ascertained by the Beverly police. Bodonax is in custody, while the weapons and ammunition have been confiscated.

According to information brought to the city, Homer Stewart, chief of police at Beverly, became suspicious of the Austrian, and accompanied by A. H. Jordan, a special constable also of Beverly, made a search of the house with the result that the articles were found.

It is said that the Winchester gun was stolen by the accused about three months ago and Chief Stewart says that he has already found the owner. The Austrian when arrested, claimed to be a naturalized Canadian, but on enquiry it was learned he had never taken out any papers.

Bodonax will appear before Magistrate Bergman at Beverly.
