The Military Prisoners Are Kept Well Do No Work.

There are now 409 suspects in Fort Henry, 114 of them being Turks. Most of the Turks are from Brantford, where they have been working in the factories there. The Italians usually go on railroad construction during the summer months and from necessity the Turks are used in their places. During the winter they seldom are given any work as they are considered poor workmen.

The prisoners are quartered in the buildings surrounding the courtyard at the fort. Kicking a football around is their usual occupation. They are willing workers and agreeable prisoners. The only work that they are made to do is keeping their own quarters clean.
