

MANY FOREIGNERS REFUSED PAPERS OF NATURALIZATION

Thirty - Three Members of
Races Hostile to Britain
Turned Down by Court.

Thirty-three applications for naturalization out of seventy-eight were refused by Judge Stone in the District Court yesterday afternoon, those to whom naturalization was refused being alien enemies. There were 26 subjects of Austria-Hungary in the number, five Germans, one Turk and one Assyrian, the last named being a subject of the Sultan.

There was one less application made for naturalization than at the sessions last June.
