

MAY COMPEL ALL CIVIL SERVICE EMPLOYEES TO BECOME NATURALIZED

Govt. Has Under Consideration
Passing of Order-in-Council
To this Effect.

Ottawa, Nov. 26.—The government has under consideration the passing of an order in council compelling all members of the civil service to become naturalized. At present appointees to the service are required to take the oath of allegiance and the oath of office. Many men of alien birth, especially in the technical branch of the service, are not naturalized. Though they take the oath of allegiance, the latter cannot be considered to be binding upon them if they sever their connection with the civil service.
