

# UNDER DETENTION

## German Baron Being Held in Montreal.

MONTREAL, Dec. 3.—Professing to be a simple farmer making inquiries about the German churches in Montreal, a well-dressed man, bearing the name of Alfred Baron Leon du Rieventhal, is now being guarded by the military authorities, having been interned by Silas H. Carpenter, registrar of alien enemies.

The baron, for all the many letters found in his pockets are so addressed to, indicate that he has travelled a great deal about Canada. His former address was Warren, Ontario, and among his papers are long accounts from the Globe hotel there, while merchants in Warren have also had large dealings with him.

But the chief interest lies in a seven page letter written in German to Herman Ridder, whose articles in the New York Staats Zeitung have been notorious for their bitter hostility to all things British.
