

PROFESSORS ARE RELEASED FROM TORONTO UNI- VERSITY.

Toronto, Dec. 5.—Three German professors of the University of Toronto have been released from their duties until the end of the term, July 1st, as a compromise with the demand of their discharge. The following official statement was last night issued by Sir Edmund Walker on behalf of the board of university governors.

"The charges against the professors were not substantiated but in view of the difficulties surrounding the situation the board has given leave of absence to Professors Mueller, Benzinger and Herr Tapper."

Sir Edmund Walker stated last night that this was as far as the board could go. President Falconer had not recommended the dismissal of the professors, and under the University Act the powers of the board were not wide enough to take an extreme step without the sanction of the president.
