

Two Austrians Interned.

Wednesday afternoon three armed guards of the Highlanders, with fixed bayonets, escorted two Austrians through the snow-covered streets to Stanley Barracks, where they were interned at the order of the military authorities and Judge Coatsworth. They were John Melnik, 142 Simcoe street, and Panik Shack, of 23 Cameron street. The men were taken before Judge Coatsworth, and thence to Inspector Kennedy's office in the City Hall, where the soldiers were handed their papers.
