

TO WORK AT PETAWAWA

Two Hundred Interned Austrians and Germans Leave Ottawa for North.

Ottawa, Dec. 10.—The first two hundred of the Austrian and German prisoners who have been interned in Canada, and who will spend the winter months putting the Petawawa military camp into shape, left for the North today. One hundred were sent from Montreal, and another hundred from Kingston. Six hundred more will be sent to Petawawa soon. The arrangements to send several hundred of the alien enemy to clear land along the line of the N. T. R. have been completed. They will be sent to Parent, a station 250 miles west of Quebec in about ten days.
