

FAIR PLAY, SAYS FALCONER.

Says University Would Regret Dismissing German Professors.

Toronto, Dec. 11.—In a statement to the press President Falconer of the University of Toronto, stated that the university was paying full salaries to those of its staff who are serving at the front with the allies, and that no preferential treatment is being accorded to the German professors who have been granted leave of absence. "We should do as the Germans do," said the principal. "I am sure that if we dismiss these men we would regret it on looking back." His action in refusing to dismiss the professors was prompted solely by his conception of British fair play and justice.
