

# AUSTRIAN RESERVIST MOBBED AT EMERSON

How real the spy peril is in Winni-peg cannot be estimated, but the fact remains that every now and again some Austrian or German makes a bold effort to get across the border into the States, presumably on the first lap towards his home country. Information previously gathered could then be very easily handed over to the warring faction for use against the allies.

The local militia and the immigration authorities, however, are keeping their eyes wide open for just such contingencies, and yesterday another arrest was effected when Deomy Moldvan, an Austrian, was turned back at Emerson and is now in the guard house at Fort Osborne barracks. He was making an effort to get over the border when the suspicions of the immigration authorities at Emerson were aroused; he was found to be an Austrian reservist. He was at once sent back to the city. He will be sent to Brandon, where he will join the rest of the prisoners now held in the concentration camp at that point.
