REGISTRATION OF ALIENS TO TAKE YEAR

Yesterday 387 allens had reg-

istered at 112 Colony street, and the average of 75 a day appears to have been pretty well maintained. That the registration of these aliens will run

into next winter seems an assured

fact now since the records held by the police show that there are 30,000 Austrian and German aliens in the city. At the rate of 100 a day this will take the best part of a year. The militia officlais, however, are inclined to shave these figures to 20,000, but even so the work undertaken is voluminous and excluding Sundays and holidays it can well be seen how long the task is going to take. Up to date no difficulty has been met with in connection with the registration. All the aliens of the belligerent countries appear to be anxious to get their names on the rolls and appear equally anxious to supply all the

information desired from them by the authorities.
