Those in Ottawa Desire Work More Than Any Thing. So far no aliens of enemy nationality from Ottawa have been interned at Petawawa or other centers. The foreigners who are to undergo internment are only those whom the authorities have reason to believe will not live up to the undertaking which every allen is forced to sign.

ALIEN ENEMIES PEACEFUL

An alien registration office has been opened at 40 Bank street for the registration of allens in the Capital There are more than a thousand of these in the city, those of Austrian nationality being in the majority, numbering fully 80 per cent. The remainder are Germans. Not one

subject of the Ottoman empire has registered. The local office is under the direction of the department of justice and is managed by Mr. W. D. Erwin. Similar offices have been establish-

ed in other large citles such as Montreal, Toronto and Winnipeg. Each alien is required to sign an taking to abide by the laws of Canada and the United Kingdom, and to agree to in no way supply informaenemy. In Ottawa the hundreds of aliens are quite docile and need work more than anything else. Most of these unfortunate men are wiscout employment, many having been out of work for many months. Chiefly they hall from Galicia, where the fighting has been thickest, and the ngaing that occur inverses, and the bulk of them are Austrian reservists with dependents, for whom they have been unable to live news for four or five months, and of them and that they have any as len in the family who look to them for

support. They are required to report once a month; in special cases. oftener.
