### **Government Locates Farm for Them West of Cochrane.**

The location of the Ontario Government's new experimental farm in Northern Ontario, upon which Austrian and German prisoners of war will supply the winter labor, has been chosen. The farm, which is a thousand acres in extent, will be surveyed upon the banks of the Kapuskasing River, in O'Brien Township, seventy miles west of Cochrane, or half way to Hearst along the Transcontinental Railway. This is located in the centre of the clay belt, but the land is now heavily timbered. The work of the prisoners during the winter will be to fell the trees and clean up the underbrush.
