FOREIGNERS AT TORONTO SHOWED BASE TREACHERY

Begged for Meals While Had Money Hidden on Person.

Toronto, Dec. 16. — Seventy-three foreigners who were taking advantage of the free meals supplied by the city at the House of Industry, in spite of the fact that they were well supplied with money, were arrested Monday. Bills ranging in denomina-

tion from \$1 to \$20 were found in pur-

ses, in belts and sewn in the clothes, of all the men detained. All too had silver in their pockets. When the money was counted it totalled \$1,374.77. This only included cash. Besides the money many of the men had bank books showing deposits of from \$50 to \$100. On many of the men

were found receipts for sums of mo-

ey sent to Europe. These sums are

from \$25 to \$200.
